# **Reading level scores**

"Regardless of literacy levels, all users want to be able to interact with government easily. Respect their time by writing in plain language. Check that your content is a reading level 2 (Australian year 7 equivalent). This level also helps users with higher literacy. "

#### **Flesch Kincaid**

Score	School level	Notes
100 - 90	Grade 5	Very easy to read. Easily understood by an average 11 year old student.
90 - 80	Grade 6	Easy to read. Conversational English for consumers.
80 - 70	Year 7	Fairly easy to read.
70 - 60	Year 8 - 9	Plain English. Easily understood by 13 to 15 year old students.
60 - 50	Year 10 - 12	Fairly difficult to read.
50 - 40	College	Difficult to read.
30 - 10	College graduate	Very difficult to read. Best understood by university graduates.
10 - 0	Professional	Extremely difficult to read. Best understood by university graduates.






#### "Readability is more than a number"




#### Gov sites: Reading scores




